Case of the Month: August 2024

Sparkling:

White Blend, De Bortoli Jean Pierre Brut NV (Australia) \$10.99

A light and dangerously drinkable sparkler with aromas of citrus, flowers, fresh cream and bread dough. On the palate you'll find complimentary notes of fresh buttered toast and a citrus freshness. Did someone say Brunch?!

White:

Pinot Grigio, Gabriella 2022 (Italy) \$10.99

A classic Italian white with flavors of lemon, lime, pear, and a hint of golden apple. Splash a bit of this into your scampi and enjoy a big glass too!

Macabeo, Collado 2021 (Spain) \$10.99

Pale yellow color, with vibrant green hints. Elegant nose of tropical fruit and citrus. Fresh, balanced and long in the mouth.

Chardonnay, Bulletin Place 2023 (Australia) \$10.99 This wine is a balance of stone fruit and layers of texture on the palate. Round and luscious while retaining the beautiful melon, white peach and pineapple fruit flavors.

Blend, Broadbent Vinho Verde NV (Portugal) \$11.99 A long-time Bin 604 Staff fave, this wine is fruity with a light spritz on the tongue and notes of green apple, citrus, and minerals. Slightly frizzante, the Broadbent is crisp and clean, delicious to drink as an aperitif.

Rose:

Blend, Protocolo Rosé 2023 (Portugal) \$10.99 Pale glazed cherry, clean and brilliant. Aroma of wild strawberries, light notes of anise and fresh fruit. On the palate it is fresh & balanced with smooth acidity. Elegant fruit finish.

Red:

Cabernet Sauvignon, Bulletin Place 2023 (Australia) \$10.99

This Aussie Cabernet Sauvignon is an attractive fruit driven red. Full bouquet of fresh berries complimented by subtle French oak. Ripe plum characters flow smoothly onto the palate, integrated spice and vanilla oak.

D'Arenberg "The Stump Jump" 2018 (Australia) \$14.99 A blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Mouvredre.—This is a value packed wine that punches well above its weight. The bouquet is open and fruit driven displaying an abundance of red and black fruits, mixed with deft touches of spice and earthiness

Tempranillo, Montebuena 2020 (Spain) \$11.99
Brilliant deep ruby red color, fruity aromas. Montebuena Red has a spicy vanilla bouquet and is smooth and fruity in the mouth with some well-integrated secondary nuances, full-flavored and a persistent pleasant finish.

Pinot Noir, Between the Vines NV (California) \$11.99 A light, fresh Pinot with ripe red fruit and juxtaposing notes of earthy mushrooms. Full of dark, brambly berries and just a touch of cocoa for a smooth and seductive finish.

Garnacha/Syrah, Collado 2022 (Spain) \$10.99

Mouthwatering wild berry and black cherry intertwined with a little earth and black pepper on a silky texture. Pair with pizza, burgers and your favorite roast meats.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Casalini 2021 (Italy) \$12.99 This wine is made from grapes grown in the hilly section of Abruzzo, on terrains sloping down toward the sea. Bright red fruits balanced by earth and spices.
